- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order with Councilmember McCoy giving invocation and pledge to the flag.
- Agenda amended to remove item # 10, discussion of purchase of concrete saw.
- Councilmember McCoy made a motion to approve the Minutes from the June 3, 2013 council meeting as presented, seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all in favor.
- Public Comments - Ellen Briggs thanked the Town for quickly addressing a clogged drain pipe under Dicks Hill Parkway near her property.
- Department reports – Heard from Chief Allen the water loss for the month of June was 7.6%, down from 15% the previous month. 21 backflows have been installed, 78 are remaining and should be completed before the end of summer.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to approve payment to UGA Archway Partnership in the amount of \$3,000. Seconded by Councilmember Ayers, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember McCoy made a motion to continue Intergovernmental Agreement with Habersham County for animal control services for \$3,039 for the year covering 7/1/13 – 6/30/14. Seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Mayor Morris asked Councilmember Tullis to start looking for a generator and sump pump for the water department.
- Councilmember McAllister conveyed thanks from Rodney Beck for being allowed to attend the water conference
- Mayor Morris shared information he learned at the annual GMA conference, including an opportunity to purchase playground equipment. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to allow Mayor Morris to make a purchase of playground equipment up to \$1,500. Seconded by Councilmember Ayers, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember McCoy made a motion to authorize the purchase of a gift card in the amount of \$500 to be given to Councilmember Hughes to help with added expenses due to illness. Seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Short discussion of final details for Cities Day event.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all in favor.
