- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order with Councilmember McAllister giving invocation and pledge to the flag.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to approve the Minutes from the March & April council meetings as presented, seconded by Councilmember Ayers, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember McCoy made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Presentation by Mike Duncan from Verity Bank moved to the June agenda at the request of Mr. Duncan.
- Public comment – heard from Habersham County Commissioner Andrea Harper that the dome is near completion at the new courthouse.
- Department reports – water meter replacement nearly completed, will start backflow installation.
- Old business – Todd Crumbley will have plans ready in a few weeks for Town Hall renovations.
- Discussion to set a date for rescheduling Cities Day. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to reschedule Georgia Cities Day and car show to July 6, 2013, naming that day “Irene Gibson Day”, seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to appoint Sheri Berrong, Town Clerk as the Pension Committee Secretary for the Town of Mount Airy, seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Mayor Morris informed the Council that the Town has made application to become a Village Post Office for U.S. Postal Service, will provide updates as they become available.
- Discussion of Public Entity Environmental Liability Insurance. After some discussion, it was decided more research was needed to make a decision. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to allow Mayor and Mayor Pro-Tempe to research and commit up to \$1600 for purchase of Public Entity Environmental Liability Insurance, if deemed necessary, seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Discussion of UGA Archway projects. Mayor Morris informed the Council the Archway Program accepted the Old School House renovation project but did not accept the Town Park project at this time.
- Discussion of building permit fees. Clarification was given to fees in place, no changes made, no action taken.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
