- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order.

- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to re-appoint Duncan & Kitchens as CPA, seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to re-appoint Judge Robert Sneed as City Judge, seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember Ayers made a motion to re-appoint Councilmember McCoy as Mayor Pro Tempe, seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all in favor. (Councilmember McCoy abstained from vote.)
- Councilmember McCoy made a motion to accept the minutes from December 2, 2013 council meeting as presented, seconded by Councilmember Hughes, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to accept the agenda as presented, seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Department reports: GCIC in good shape, no backflows installed in December due to illness, holidays and other projects.
- Old business: Water committee will be setting up meetings with contractors to review water line bids in the coming month.
- The date set for Cities Day 2014 will be Saturday, April 19th. Rain date will be determined at a later time.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to authorize Mayor Morris to sign Fire Protection agreement with the City of Cornelia, pending verification of numbers. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
