- Mayor Morris called the hearing to order at 7:00 p.m.
- He then asked for public comment regarding the proposed millage rate of 3.91 mills for the 2014 tax year. No public comments were made; Mayor Morris closed the public hearing.

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- Meeting was called to order, invocation & pledge delivered by Mayor Morris.
- Agenda was accepted as presented. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to accept minutes from September 8, 2014 meeting as presented. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- During Public Comments, Sharon Fleischer addressed the Mayor & Council about several items. She reported loud music coming from Cross Road; Chief Allen said he would address the issue. She thanked the Town for the placement of corrected street signs on Lois Lane Drive. Next she requested street repairs be made at Sixth Street & Keller Road. She also reported that food was stolen from her garden and knives were found there: she turned them over to the officer on duty at the time. Her husband also addressed the council about fence regulations and acceptable materials.
- During department reports, Chief Allen informed the council that GCIC is in good condition with no delinquent accounts. He also reported that some street signs had been replaced, as well as "child at play" signs. He reported that a pre-construction meeting was scheduled with Arrowood Construction for October 8, 2014. Clerk reported that business license renewals had been mailed and that Property Tax bills would be mailed before October 20, 2014, pending approval of the millage rate.
- Next, Councilmember McAllister made a motion to set the 2014 Property Tax millage rate at 3.91. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to approve a business license for Chris Green dba Kelkad Project management. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Hughes, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember Tullis made a motion to enter into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing personnel. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Hughes, passed with all in favor.
- After a brief time, Mayor and Council returned from Executive Session. Councilmember Tullis made a motion to return to regular session. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Hughes, passed with all in favor.
- Upon returning to regular session Mayor Morris announced the Town would raise the hourly pay rate for Evan Shirley to \$12.00 per hour effective 10/6/2014.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all in favor.
