- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., invocation & pledge delivered by Councilmember McCoy.
- Agenda was amended to add an executive session to discuss personnel, and then accepted as amended.
- Councilmember Ayers made a motion to accept minutes from October 6, 2014 meeting as presented. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- No comments from the public at this meeting.
- During department reports, Chief Allen informed the council that GCIC is in good condition with no delinquent accounts. Water line project is ahead of schedule. Park updates are complete. Property tax payments are starting to come in. Upcoming events are Mt. Airy Civic Assoc. fundraiser for Mark Lewallen Dec. 6th, Christmas in Mt. Airy Dec. 11th at the Old Schoolhouse, Employee Christmas Dinner Dec. 12th.
- Also discussed during department reports was the need to replace the fencing around the Chase Road water tank. After a brief discussion, Councilmember McCoy made a motion to accept the bid from Hercules Fencing for \$7,552. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all in favor.
- Next, Councilmember McAllister made a motion to enter into executive session for the purpose of discussing personnel. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- After a brief time, Mayor and Council returned from Executive Session. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to return to regular session. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Upon returning to regular session no action was taken pertaining to the executive session.
- Mayor Morris then discussed the sealing & striping of Town Hall parking lot. After a short discussion. Councilmember McCoy made a motion to accept the bid from Lawns Unlimited for \$4,425. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all in favor.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
