- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m., and then Councilmember McCoy led the invocation & pledge.
- Agenda was accepted as presented.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to accept the minutes from February 2, 2015 meeting as presented. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Ayers, passed with all in favor.
- David Brown from the Northeast Georgian Newspaper introduced himself as our assigned reporter. Also, Habersham County Commission Chair Victor Anderson introduced himself.
- During department reports, Chief Allen reported GCIC was in good shape. He also reported that he had been in touch with the Georgia DOT engineer who is going to help him prepare a bid request package for the Keller Road widening project. Chief Allen reported that during the recent storm, some equipment had been damaged. He also commended Evan Shirley for putting forth a great effort in keeping the roads clear. Water loss number is unavailable this month due to purchasing water from Cornelia to supplement our supply during loss. Councilmember McCoy reported that Office Don Ford continues to recover from a recent illness and appreciates the thoughts and prayers of the Town. Clerk Berrong reported that only a few businesses remained that need to renew their business license for 2015 and that letters would go out to those businesses. She also reported that FIFA's would be filed on any unpaid property taxes.
- Mayor Morris again presented proposed changes to Town Ordinance §30-23 Article II Unlawful Acts to include in paragraph (b) (2) the language "... or at any time or place so as to annoy or disturb the quiet, comfort or repose of persons in any office, dwelling, hotel or other type of residence or of any persons in the vicinity ...". Councilmember McAllister made a motion to accept the change as presented. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
- Keller Road project was discussed during department reports.
- Mayor Morris opened the discussion regarding the Old Schoolhouse, coming to the following conclusions:
 - Template "A" is the preliminary floor plan.

- Need to get two more bids on HVAC.
- Need one more bid on handicap ramp & porch.

- Mayor & Council scheduled a work session to be held Wednesday, March 4, 2015 at 3 p.m. at the Old Schoolhouse 1231 Dicks Hill Pkwy to discuss progress on the Old Schoolhouse projects, Keller Road paving project, water projects and ordinances. A quorum will be present but no official votes will be taken.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
