- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then Councilmember McAlister led the invocation & pledge.
- Agenda was accepted as presented.
- Minutes from March 2, 2015 Council meeting and March 16, 2015 Work session were accepted as presented.
- During public comments Andrea Harper, County Commissioner, was present to remind the Mayor and Council of an upcoming Joint County/City reception to be held Thursday, April 16, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. She also reported on the industrial park and airport progress. Next, Mr. Terry Tyler addressed the Mayor & Council regarding ongoing issues with a neighbor to a family member on Fourth Street. Chief Allen was directed to address issue these issues with the neighbor in question.
- During department reports, Chief Allen reported GCIC was in good shape. He also reported that he had received an estimate for the necessary road repairs at Russell Woods subdivision. It should be noted that Russell Woods streets are private roads, never accepted by the City. However information was gathered after a request was made by a citizen in the area. The estimate from JK Paving came in \$36,200 for repairs and \$102,500 for replacement. Water loss was reported to be approximately 17% this month. Councilmember McCoy reported that Office Don Ford continues to recover from a recent illness and appreciates the thoughts and prayers of the Town. Clerk Berrong reported all FIFA's had been filed on unpaid property taxes. Cities Day was discussed; opening ceremony was shortened to an invocation, Mayor's welcome, presentation of the colors and pledge. Senior breakfast has been moved to 8:30 a.m. at Ebenezer Baptist Church.
- Mayor Morris opened a discussion regarding the Old Schoolhouse project, stating a called meeting or work session was necessary to discuss the scope of work necessary for each aspect of the project. Mayor & Council scheduled a called meeting to be held Wednesday, April 15, 2015 at 4 p.m. at the Old Schoolhouse 1231 Dicks Hill Pkwy to discuss progress on the Old Schoolhouse projects.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all in favor.
