- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then Councilmember McCoy led the invocation & pledge.
- Councilmember McCoy made a motion to amend the agenda to include an executive session to discuss personnel. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all favor.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to approve the minutes from April 6, 2015 Council meeting as presented. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- During public comments Don Ford was present to express his gratitude to the Town for their support during his recent illness and continued recovery.
- During department reports, Chief Allen reported that a meeting was scheduled to take place between Mr. Barker and Cindy Tyler regarding recent issues on Fourth Street. The meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, April 8, 2015 at 2 pm. The same parties will also be at Municipal Court on Tuesday, April 14, 2015. He reported some residents on Main St. are requesting the trees on Main Street be trimmed as they are an obstruction to the road. It was agreed that the trees would be removed if the residents were in agreement. Chief Allen then reported that he had heard back Georgia Department of Transportation regarding the Keller Road widening project and that he would be preparing an RFP to solicit estimates. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to proceed with the project. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Next on the agenda was consideration of an intergovernmental agreement for Habersham County to conduct elections for the Town of Mount Airy. After a brief discussion, Councilmember McCoy made a motion to authorize Mayor Morris to sign said agreement. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all in favor.
- The next item for consideration was the memorandum of understanding to (enter) continue using Habersham Archway Partnership. After a brief discussion, Councilmember McCoy made a motion to authorize Mayor Morris to sign the MOU, contingent upon notifying them that we considering dropping out of the program for the next fiscal year. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Up for discussion next was the Old Schoolhouse project. Mayor Morris informed the council that we were nearing completion of the RFP's for the city attorney's review and those would be posted as soon as possible.
- Next, Councilmember McCoy made a motion to enter in executive session to discuss personnel. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all in favor.
- Upon returning from executive session, Councilmember McAllister made a motion to return to regular session. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
- No actions were taken in executive session, no motions needed to be brought before the council.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
