- Agenda was accepted as presented.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to accept minutes from the May 4, 2015 as presented. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- No comments from the public at this meeting.
- During department reports, Clerk Berrong reported that the first RFP's for the Schoolhouse project had been posted. Also, she and Chief Allen had begun work on preparing the RFP for the Keller Road widening project.
- Next on the agenda was consideration of a revised Inter-Governmental Agreement for Habersham County to conduct elections for the Town of Mount Airy. Mayor Morris explained the changes were minimal and mentioned that the City Attorney had reviewed the revised agreement and found no problem with it. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to authorize Mayor Morris to sign said agreement. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Mayor Morris opened a short discussion about the Old Schoolhouse project. He reminded Council that the responses to the first two RFPs would be in soon and asked to schedule a called meeting. The called meeting was scheduled for Monday, June 15, 2015 at 6 pm at Town Hall.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
