- Mayor Morris called to order the regular scheduled council meeting, then Councilmember McCoy led the invocation and pledge.
- Agenda was accepted as presented.
- The Minutes from meeting held March 7th, 2016 were presented. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to approve minutes as presented. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- No public comments were made.
- During department reports, Chief Allen reported that water loss was up due to a number of small leaks. He also reported he had received a lot of positive feedback about the new playground pieces installed at the park. Mayor Morris asked him to get an estimate for a concrete pad to add another pavilion. GCIC numbers are up from the same quarter last year. Clerk Berrong reported that SPLOST V funds were completely depleted, and spending from SPLOST VI had started. She also reported that LMIG funds were received in the amount of \$19,083.58.
- Belinda Sue Keller made a request of the Mayor and Council to transfer the Alcohol License issued to Roy Lee Keller, Lake Russell 1 Stop Convenience Store to her, due to his death. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to transfer the license to Belinda Sue Keller. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Mayor Morris then expressed a need to schedule a work session. After a brief discussion, it was agreed upon to have a work session on Wednesday, April 20th at noon at Town Hall.
- In regards to Cities Day, no news to report. Breakfast and children’s activities have been confirmed, only waiting to hear about the rock climbing wall from the National Guard.
- Mayor Morris reported that the back left room was being finished at the schoolhouse. He also presented pictures of council benches for the council to review and consider. Updates were given on most aspects, no action was taken.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
