- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., then led the invocation and pledge.
- Agenda was accepted as presented.
- A discussion was opened about the emergency need to relocate the GCIC and Police departments to the Old Schoolhouse as quickly as possible. Recent issues with internet service and the addition of a new customer has made it necessary to relocate as quickly as possible to utilize fiber optic internet service, as well as expanding the work area to accommodate more work stations. Mayor Morris explained the cost to complete this in a timely manner would be approximately \$45,000, to include but not limit it to the following: HEMC internet installation, refurbishing new room for Police and GCIC departments, data reinstallations and other related costs. Included in the estimate of \$45,000 is the one-time fee from HEMC to bring fiber services to the building, paid in monthly installments over a five year period, interest free. Councilmember McCoy made a motion to approve the emergency expenditures to accommodate the move of GCIC and Police departments to the Old Schoolhouse. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all in favor.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all in favor.
