- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm, then Councilmember McCoy led the invocation and pledge.
- Agenda was amended to include discussion of garbage service. Motion made by Councilmember Tullis, seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
- Minutes from the January 7, 2019 regular meeting and January 24, 2019 work session were presented. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilmember Green, passed with all in favor.
- No comments from the public.
- During department reports, Public Works director presented pictures of the property at 436 Railroad Ave and asked for direction on how to proceed with repairs. It was agreed to repair the front section to divert water away from the structure and to look at more extensive updates at a later time. He reported they are working on cleaning up the underpasses and addressing water issues, as well as maintenance at the cemetery.
- Next was the final reading and consideration of a Resolution to call for a special election to be held June 18, 2019 to fill the vacant seat on the council. Councilmember Tullis made a motion to pass said resolution. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Green, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember Tullis asked that research be done to see if it is feasible for the Town to handle garbage service for its residents. Chief Jarrell had rough estimates but said he would gather more information to be discussed at a later date. No action was taken.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Tullis made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Green, passed with all in favor.
