- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order, then led the invocation and pledge.
- Agenda was accepted as presented.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to accept minutes from February 5, 2018 meeting as presented. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- During public comments, Patrick Ledford introduced himself and announced his intention to qualify and run for the open council seat. Also, Andrea Harper from the Habersham County Commissioners office thanked the town for hosting the last Comprehensive Plan meeting and providing the meal.
- During department reports, PW director James Kimsey gave an update on the foyer project upstairs, which is nearly complete. Still within the \$5,000 budgeted but may need an increase to complete it.
- Next, Ed Nichols with the Habersham County Bicentennial Committee spoke. He reminded the council that they meet the first Thursday of each month, the book committee meets each Tuesday at Clarkesville library. The sell price of the book will be \$25. He said the Committee will have a table at our Cities Day to pass out info regarding the Bicentennial. County manager Phil Sutton spoke up and said the County has been actively fundraising for the Bicentennial.
- The last item for discussion was Cities Day. A brief overview was given of the museum and the work needed to be completed by Cities Day.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
