- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order, then Councilmember McCoy led the invocation and pledge.
- Agenda was amended to add the following items: Consideration of resolution authorizing Mayor Morris to sign the Service Delivery Strategy. Also, discussion of railroad leases. Motion to amend agenda as noted was made by Councilmember McAllister. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to accept minutes from March 5, 2018 meeting as presented. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Ayers, passed with all in favor.
- During department reports, Manager Jarrell reported the upstairs foyer was complete and we were on track to have the elevator operational by Cities Day. Clerk Berrong reported property tax collections at approximately 98%, business license renewals were complete with the exception of three, which are being addressed.
- No public was present for comment.
- Council considered the Intergovernmental Agreement with Habersham County for Animal Control Services as discussed during a recent work session. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to enter into IGA with Habersham County for Animal Control Services (\$8,527 for FY2019). Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Next up, the council considered the intergovernmental agreement with Habersham County for Radio Maintenance Fees as discussed during a recent work session. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to enter into IGA with Habersham County for radio maintenance fees (\$199.60 per unit FY2019). Motion was seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
- The next item for consideration was the railroad leases. Mayor Morris gave a brief history of the negotiations and after a brief discussion Councilmember Tullis made a motion authorizing Mayor Morris to negotiate a new consolidated lease up to \$1,000. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McAllister, passed with all in favor.
- The last item for consideration was a resolution authorizing Mayor Morris to sign the Service Delivery Strategy Plan. Councilmember McAllister made a motion authorizing Mayor Morris to sign the Service Delivery Strategy Plan. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor,

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
