- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order, then led the invocation and pledge.
- Newly elected councilmember Christopher Green was sworn in by Mayor Morris. Mayor Morris then appointed him to the following three committees: Public Safety and GCIC, Ray McAllister was appointed as chairperson of said committee. Also Finance & Taxation committee as well as Personnel, Ordinances & Annexations.
- Agenda was accepted as presented.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to accept minutes from May 7, 2018 meeting as presented. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- During public comments, local resident Cherie Bowman introduced herself and expressed an interest in becoming more involved. Mayor Morris invited her to join the museum committee.
- During department reports, Chief/Manager Jarrell, SPLOST revenue received is at approx. 45%. Current SPOLST funds will be used as the match for LMIG funds, the Keller Road paving project to take place before October. He also reported that Public Works is currently working on the right-of-ways. Also working on locating valves. Chief/Manager Jarrell is also working with the railroad about addressing the bridges in town. He requested a date for a future work session to discuss comp plan and water tank needs. Clerk Berrong presented reconciled bank balances.
- The council held the first reading of the Habersham County Animal Control ordinances, to be adopted by Mount Airy as per the intergovernmental agreement with Habersham County.
- The next item for consideration was a request to accept the right-of-way deed for Russell Woods Subdivision. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to accept said right-of-ways. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
- After a brief discussion, a work session was planned for Wednesday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 2 pm.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
