- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order, then Councilmember McCoy led the invocation and pledge.
- Mayor Morris requested the agenda be amended to include consideration of resolution to enter into Intergovernmental Agreement with Habersham County for the use and distribution of proceeds generated by the 2018 transportation special purpose local option sales tax referendum. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to amend agenda as requested, motion was seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember McAllister made a motion to accept minutes from June 4th, 2018 and June 20th, 2018 meetings. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
- During department reports, Public Works director updated the mayor and council on a number of ongoing projects including bridge repair (working with the railroad), well houses, patching and paving of roads and locating lines and valves. Clerk Berrong reported that the Town had received \$10,475.03 from FEMA/GEMA for Hurricane Irma disaster recovery. She also reported that the first steps had been taking in preparing for the 2018 property tax season, and reported that the Habersham County Tax Commissioner had changed their tax bill due date to November 20th. She requested that the council consider changing Mount Airy's tax bill due date to coincide with the County, no action was taken at this time.
- The council then considered the resolution to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Habersham County for the use and distribution of proceeds generated by the 2018 transportation special purpose local option sales tax referendum. After a brief discussion, Councilmember McAllister made a motion to accept resolution, motion was seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Green, passed with all in favor.
