- Mayor Morris called the hearing to order to receive public comments regarding the 2018 proposed millage rate of 3.91 mills. Hearing none, Councilmember McCoy made a motion to adjourn the public hearing, motion seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Mayor Morris then called the council meeting to order, invocation and pledge led by Councilmember McCoy
- Agenda was accepted as presented.
- Minutes from August 6, 2018 accepted as presented.
- No public present to comment.
- During department reports, Chief Jarrell had nothing to report. Public Works Director James Kimsey reported still working on locating valves and working on the schoolhouse. He also reported the hydrant on Wilson Road had been repaired. Clerk Berrong presented reconciled bank balances. She reported upon adoption of a millage rate, Harris is prepared to start working on tax bills and should be mailed by month's end. She also requested a list of dates for the annual employee Christmas dinner. Mayor Morris reported GCIC had a good month.
- At this time, Chief/Manager Jarrell addressed the council about a need to appoint new members to the Planning Commission. After a recommendation from Chief/Manager Jarrell, Mayor Morris asked for a motion to appoint Patrick Ledford and Nokia Moore to the Planning Commission. Motion made by Councilmember Tullis, seconded by Councilmember Green, passed with all in favor. Planning Commission now consists of Nokia Moore, Patrick Ledford, Richard McMillan and Ron Glaze, one seat still vacant.
- Next item on agenda was adoption of 2018 millage rate, proposed at 3.91 mills, tax bills due date of Dec. 20, 2018. Motion made by Councilmember McCoy, seconded by Councilmember Ayers, passed with all in favor.
- Last item for consideration was an amendment to Ordinance 2-481 to add Town Manager as an authorized signature for banking purposes. Motion made by Councilmember Tullis, seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Green, passed with all in favor.
