Council Meeting
November 5th, 2018 7:00 pm

- Mayor Morris called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm, then Councilmember McCoy led the invocation and pledge.
- Next, Mayor Morris requested a motion to amend the agenda to add an executive session to discuss personnel. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to amend agenda as requested. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Minutes from the October 1st, 2018 meeting were presented. Councilmember Tullis made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilmember Ayers, passed with all in favor.
- No public was present to comment, however Mayor Morris stated he had received two requests from residents on Keller Road for the speed bumps to be replaced. Chief Jarrell said he was looking into a speed sign, also said we need to set a speed limit on Keller Rd. He informed the council that in order to run radar there, an engineering study had to be completed and sent to Georgia Department of Transportation. They asked him to investigate the cost. After a brief discussion, Councilmember McCoy made a motion to set the speed limit on Keller Road at 25 miles per hour. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Green, passed with all in favor.
- During department reports, Public Works Director James Kimsey reported work was continuing upstairs, working on getting a map of existing water lines at Meeks trailer park, also that the Water Department had taken delivery of a new truck. Clerk Berrong presented reconciled bank balances and reported that the new truck was paid in full with SPLOST VI proceeds. Next she asked the council to set a date for a public hearing for the 2019 proposed budget. Date was set for Monday, November 19th at 6 pm, with adoption of the proposed budget to take place at the next council meeting set for December 3rd. Chief Jarrell requested that we add discussion of proposed tap fee increases to the December 3 agenda. He also requested that a discussion of how to use projected LMIG funds be added as well.
- Next, a resolution to adopt to Habersham County Joint Comprehensive Plan was considered. Councilmember McAllister made a motion to adopt the resolution. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.
- Councilmember Tullis made a motion to enter into executive session to discuss personnel. Motion was seconded by Councilmember McCoy, passed with all in favor.
- After a while, Councilmember McAllister made a motion to return to regular session. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Tullis, passed with all in favor.

With no other business to discuss, Councilmember Ayers made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Green, passed with all in favor.
